### The Meeting in Sofia

It was not the first time, that the Bulgarian Partner hosted a Rasmorad Meeting. This is a sign of intense involvement in the Project, and awareness towards a phenomenon, which has not very big numbers in the Bulgarian P & P System, but, for this reason too, must be carefully detected and possibly prevented in that context.

This belief was clearly expressed by the Head of General Directorate for Execution of Sentences, and by the Deputy Minister of Justice, who gave their welcome to the participants.

The second of them, Prof. Prodanov, pointed out on the good results that are expected from the intense cooperation with the Ministry of Interiors, on subjects like intelligence and analysis, in order to prevent terroristic attacks.
